







#### Overview

We operate an alkali-accelerated solvent-based immersion stripping facility that is capable of removing polyester powder from most metals. The active ingredient is Benzyl Alcohol.

The process is free from hydrocarbons, phenols and cresols.

The plant is the same size as the powder coating plant so if we can powder coat it we can also remove the paint ourselves.

We accept previously painted material for paint removal before powder coating or shot blasting.

## **Key Points**

- Chemical based process. No heat distortion

### Plant

The plant is located within the premises to retain control of all material at Powdertech.

The plant consists of 2 stainless steel tanks 6500mm long, 600mm wide and 1650mm deep. They are parallel to each other and material is moved from one to the other by overhead crane.

Material is loaded into a stainless-steel basket or cantilever bar before rising and traversing to the first of 2 stages. Stage 1 is immersion into the heated "strip" solution which is moved by powerful jets to soften and erode coatings without affecting the metal substrate. Stage 2 is an air-agitated water rinse to thoroughly clean the metal. Due to the unknown nature of the paint such as the thickness, the process is closely monitored and requires timing and judgement and only moves forward once the stage has been completed.

Painted steel can be difficult to shot blast but with the inclusion of a stripping stage before blasting the old paint can be softened to reduce metal erosion.

#### **Process**

Stages are for general information. Actual sequence may change or repeat depending on the material type, condition and finish.

- Alkali-accelerated solvent-based immersion. Heated and pressure agitated.
- 2. Agitated water rinse.
- 3. Pressure wash (optional)
